

ORDER REQUIRING FACE COVERING

In Order to protect court staff and personnel, law enforcement and court officers, litigants, attorneys, news media and the general public due to the COVID-19 pandemic, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

A face covering as defined in the Standing Order of the Chief Judge of the Superior Court of Henry County dated May 13, 2015 shall be required to be worn by all persons while in the courtrooms of the Magistrate Court of Henry County, Georgia which are located at: One Judicial Center, McDonough, Georgia 30253; and the jail of the Henry County Sheriff's Office, 120 Henry Parkway, McDonough, Georgia 30253. Persons failing to abide by this Order may be attached and punished for contempt of court.
