

Questions and Answers

1. **Question:** Item 17 under Section I.B. General Instructions, Terms, and Conditions (page 7 of 24) states that compliance with the Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act shall be attested by the Contractor and any of his Subcontractors by execution of the appropriate Affidavit. A laboratory will be subcontracted for analytical services under this contract; do we need to submit a Subcontractor Affidavit with this bid or after contract award? If the Subcontractor Affidavit needs to be submitted with the bid, will we need to use a separate form or will a copy of the Contractor's affidavit suffice?
Answer: As long as the laboratory is certified, it does not matter.
2. **Question:** Item #4 under Scope of Work (top of page 13 of 24) states that the Engineering Consultant will be responsible for only compliance monitoring and reporting services for years (2) through five (5). Does this statement refer to Years 2-5 of the contract, or Years 2-5 of the 2017 General Permit?
Answer: In this case the contract term coincides with the permit cycle
3. **Question:** Is Henry County currently registered with the Georgia EPD Online System (GEOS) for permitting and reporting?
Answer: Yes
4. **Question:** This facility is listed as covered under the 2012 General Industrial Permit. Does the facility have a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) that will be available for review?
Answer: Yes
5. **Question:** How many storm-water outfalls does the facility have (annual storm-water sampling/monitoring costs will depend on the number of outfalls requiring sampling)?
Answer: Recycling center has one outfall, and fleet has two outfalls
6. **Question:** Is previous annual sampling/analytical data available for the site? If so, has the site ever failed to meet benchmark concentrations for any sector specific parameters?
Answer: No, previous data available.
7. **Question:** The Description of services under Item 3 of the Bid Price Sheet includes "required monitoring throughout the year to assure compliance and submit reports to Storm Water director or designee." Just to clarify, does this include annual sampling, quarterly routine facility inspections, quarterly visual assessments, and annual comprehensive site inspections?
Answer: Yes
