WHAT IS THE INTERNET?

The Internet, a loose collection of worldwide computer networks, has no central index. No one person or agency is in charge. The original purpose of the Internet was to share research and military information among colleges, universities and defense agencies.

Today Internet use has skyrocketed and anyone can “surf the net” Browser software can connect you with Web sites all around the world.

The unprecedented freedom of information exchange does bring with it new concerns not present with earlier forms of communication.

Information on the web may well be copyrighted just as are most books and magazines. Respect the rights of the owner. Don't pirate information.

We cannot guarantee successful connections to or within Internet service.

RULES, RESTRICTIONS AND FURTHER WARNINGS

Do not send or display obscene or disruptive messages, files or images. Do not harass, libel or slander others.

Do not use the Internet for personal profit, private, political or commercial purposes. Do not attempt to change, delete or add files to the network or hard drive.

No downloading is allowed because of the danger of viruses.

Do not play games from an Internet site, including Web sites, interactive games, etc.

Do not violate copyright laws or software license restrictions.

Do not display images, sound or text which could create an atmosphere of discomfort or harassment for others.

Do not use chat rooms or chat channels.

Personal software or hardware may not be used with HCSCS computers.

Leave the computer exactly as you found it. Do not change bookmarks, preferences or settings.
